Music is at the heart of Nightbats. Every Friday, our stage belongs to local and underground bands, while at least once a month international acts take over our Saturday nights.

On the remaining Saturdays, DJs keep the club alive with dark and alternative sounds. During exhibitions and smaller events throughout the week, music continues to flow through the halls of the club.

Tickets for international acts can be bought through platforms like Ticketmaster or Ticketcorner.

Tickets for local concerts are available directly at the door in front of the club.

Prices usually range between 20 - 40 CHF.
